**WHEREAS**, E911 Dispatchers are the single vital link for our law enforcement, firefighters and paramedics by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information and insuring their safety; and

**WHEREAS**, E911 Dispatchers of the Floyd County E911 Center have contributed substantially to the apprehension of criminals, suppression of fire and treatment of patients; and

**WHEREAS**, each dispatcher has exhibited compassion, understanding and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year.

**NOW, THEREFORE, Be It Resolved**, that the Floyd County Board of Commissioners do hereby proclaim the week of April 13-19, 2008 as
