WHEREAS, the Floyd County Emergency Management Volunteer Rescue Squad responded in a manner that reflects their dedication to the citizens of Floyd County; and

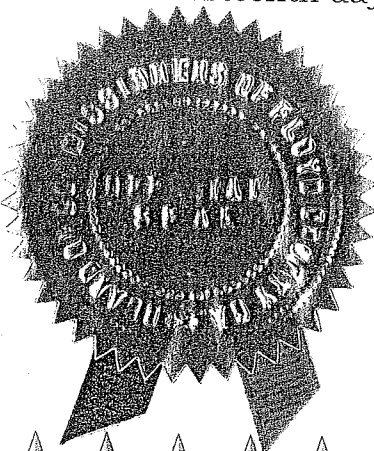
WHEREAS, the EMA volunteers were the first to respond to the scene and immediately began to access and secure the scene and assist those who were injured; and
