



**2009 CADILLAC XLR**

The Cadillac XLR roadster enters 2009 with a revised model lineup that is focused on more dramatic design, technology and craftsmanship. Cadillac's retractable hardtop roadster features new color choices, revised interior trim and enhanced electronics for 2009 -- and only the finest editions of the XLR will be offered: The luxurious XLR Platinum and the high-performance XLR-V. The XLR Platinum is equipped with a 320-horsepower 4.6L Northstar V-8 VVT. The XLR-V is powered with a 443-horsepower 4.4L Northstar V-8 supercharged engine. Changes for 2009 include an improved version of Magnetic Ride Control system and amenities such as a heated steering wheel. XLR's advanced technologies also include Adaptive Forward Lighting that enables the headlamps to swivel in concert with vehicle steering; a head-up display; StabiliTrak; heated and cooled seats; Keyless Access with push-button start; and DVD navigation and entertainment. The 2009 XLR includes a new front fascia, new rear fascia and new side fender vents. Also new is hand-cut and sewn leather used on the upper instrument panel. This hand-stitched and wrapped leather lends tailored elegance to the cabin, representing Cadillac's new approach to modern and elegant interior craftsmanship. **2009 CHEVROLET AVALANCHE**

Chevy Avalanche is the most flexible utility vehicle, combining the passenger-comfort attributes of an SUV with the cargo capability of a truck. It features segment-leading fuel economy and flex-fuel capability; a sharp, precise driving feel, interior refinement and notable quietness -- it also has a maximum towing capacity of 8,100 pounds. Avalanche's efficiency is enhanced in '09 with the new, fuel-saving six-speed automatic transmission. It helps deliver improved highway fuel mileage by incorporating two overdrive gears (fifth and sixth gears) that allow the engine to operate at a lower speed on the highway. The lower engine speed also contributes to a quieter passenger environment. The Avalanche is available in LS, LT and LTZ models, with 2WD and 4WD. The standard powertrain includes an efficient 5.3L V-8 with Active Fuel Management technology that seamlessly switches from eight-cylinder to four-cylinder operation to save fuel. A 6.0L V-8 engine with Active Fuel Management and variable valve timing (VVT) is also available. Several of Avalanche's engines are FlexFuel-capable, meaning they can run on E85 ethanol-based fuel. Avalanche's flexibility enables it to function as an SUV, truck or both, thanks to the exclusive Midgate. The Midgate opens to extend the cargo-carrying capability from the cargo bed's 5-foot-3-inch-long length to 8 feet 2 inches. **2009 CHEVROLET AVEO**

Fuel-efficient Chevrolet Aveo is an uncompromising performer, with a great design, a smooth, safe driving experience and amenities that are rare in the small-car segment. For 2009, a more powerful engine, the 1.6L Gen 3 Ecotec, is standard in all models, delivering more usable horsepower with the same great fuel efficiency. The Aveo sedan offers smart-looking styling and roomy interior characterized by thoughtful details and refinement. It also delivers confident, dynamic driving experiences and generous features usually seen in more expensive cars, challenging the expectations of what an entry-level car can deliver. In addition to the more powerful engine and the '09 Aveo lineup includes the following new or revised features: OnStar standard on all models; XM Satellite Radio available; Revised driver information center with outside temperature display and fuel economy/driving range function; New 15-inch aluminum alloy five-spoke wheels; New 15-inch steel wheel with bolt-on wheel cover; Three new exterior colors: Black Granite Metallic, Blue Moon and Tahiti Green; New Charcoal leatherette seating; and Available leather-wrapped steering wheel and shift knob (included with leatherette seating). **2009 CHEVROLET AVEO 5**

The Aveo5's signature "tall car" design boasts smooth lines and short front and rear overhangs that give it a bold personality. It was conceived for maximum versatility and practicality. New exterior styling for 2009 includes a front-end design that leaves no doubt that the Aveo5 is a contemporary Chevy. Signature, Malibu-inspired upper and lower grilles are flanked by sweeping headlamps that give this small car big attitude. At the rear, a lower fascia insert and roof-mounted spoiler complete the sporty look. The Aveo5 has a standard rear wiper/washer and 60/40 flip-and-fold seats. Aveo5's cabin reflects youthful refinement. A tall car design and generous dimension offer ample interior space -- capable of accommodating passengers more than 6 feet tall in each of the five seating positions. A combination of sound-dampening technologies and aerodynamics provides a quiet and comfortable ride, even at higher speeds. Powering the Aveo5 is of GM's sophisticated 16-valve four-cylinder engine. This 1.6L Ecotec engine features variable valve timing for optimal power and fuel efficiency. It is rated at 106 horsepower and 107 lb.-ft. of torque. A smooth-shifting, five-speed manual transmission is standard and an Aisin four-speed automatic is available. **2009 CHEVROLET COBALT**

The sleek Chevrolet Cobalt greets 2009 with enhancements that provide increased fuel efficiency. Along with more-efficient performance, the '09 Cobalt offers customer-focused enhancements that build on a package of choices, convenience and safety features. With an industry-best five-year/100,000-mile powertrain warranty, an Insurance Institute for Highway Safety "Best Pick" for safety it is no wonder the Cobalt is one of the most popular choices in the small-car segment. The 2009 Cobalt lineup includes LS, LT and the turbocharged SS models -- an SS sedan joins the ranks this year. The SS coupe and sedan are powered by a sophisticated 2.0L turbocharged and intercooled Ecotec engine that uses direct injection technology to provide a great balance of performance and fuel efficiency. The Sport Appearance Package includes a rear spoiler, larger body-color fascias and rocker moldings; 17-inch polished aluminum wheels with performance tires; chrome exhaust tip; fog lamps; white-face sport gauges; leather-wrapped steering wheel and shifter knob; and steering wheel audio controls. Variable valve timing added to the 2.2L Ecotec engine enables more efficient performance, along with an increase in horsepower from 148 to 155 hp. New exterior colors -- Silver Ice Metallic, Gold Mist Metallic and Silver Moss Metallic -- are added to the Cobalt's color palette. **2009 CHEVROLET COLORADO**

Chevy's midsize Colorado pickup enters 2009 with a host of performance enhancements, including a new, 5.3L V-8 engine option and new brake system. These features, along with the return of the Z08 sport suspension and a new family of stylish wheels, increase the Colorado's capability and refreshes its stylish appearance. Colorado's new 5.3L V-8 is available on extended cab and crew cab models. It pumps out 300 horsepower and delivers 320 lb.-ft. of torque of robust torque for an exceptional maximum towing capacity of 6,000 pounds. Effortless highway driving also is an attribute of the new V-8, enabling 0-60 mph performance of less than 7 seconds. A revised fuel control module helps most 2009 Colorado models equipped with the 2.9L and 3.7L engines achieve better fuel economy than previous models. Colorado receives a new brake system that delivers greater stopping power and an improved brake pedal feel. increases to 25 mpg -- an increase of nearly 14 percent over the '08 rating. StabiliTrak stability control is standard. Colorado is available in regular cab, extended cab and crew cab configurations, as well as 2WD and 4WD. Colorado can seat up to six. Standard features include rack-and-pinion steering, XM Satellite Radio, intermittent wipers, air conditioning, tilt steering wheel, cruise control and folding outside mirrors. **2009 CHEVROLET CORVETTE**

The 2009 Corvette lineup includes the coupe and convertible, each powered by the 430-horsepower LS3 V-8, and the incomparable Corvette Z06. Equipped with the 505-horsepower LS7 engine and built on a lightweight chassis, the Z06 is a street-going descendent of the championship-winning Corvette racing program. Three suspension choices allow drivers to choose the setup that best suits their driving style. The standard suspension is tuned for a balance of ride comfort and precise handling. The optional Magnetic Selective Ride Control suspension features magneto-rheological dampers able to detect road surfaces and adjust the damping rates to those surfaces almost instantaneously for optimal ride control. The Z51 Performance Package brings performance very close to the widely admired previous generation Z06. The Z51 offers more aggressive dampers and springs, larger stabilizer bars, Goodyear Eagle F1 Supercar EMT tires, enhanced cooling and larger cross-drilled brake rotors (13.4 inches / 340 mm in front and 13 inches / 330 mm in rear) for optimum track performance while still providing a comfortable ride. **2009 CHEVROLET EQUINOX**

Chevrolet Equinox's combination of sleek styling, confident performance, a spacious interior and good efficiency make a popular choice with compact SUV crossover customers. The Equinox arrives in the 2009 model year with enhancements to its winning formula. Head curtain side-impact airbags with rollover protection sensors are standard, as is XM Satellite radio. An all-new feature for the Equinox is Bluetooth connectivity available with the OnStar system. It enables hands-free phone calling in connection with the vehicle audio system. There are also three new exterior colors: Silver Ice Metallic, Gold Mist Metallic and Cyber Gray Metallic. The Equinox is available in LS, LT, LTZ and Sport models, each available with all-wheel drive. The performance-oriented Equinox Sport packs a unique 3.6L V-6 engine and six-speed automatic transmission. The five-passenger Equinox is one of the few compact SUVs equipped with a standard V-6 engine. It is powered by a 3.4L V-6, rated at 185 horsepower and 210 lb.-ft. of torque. Equinox Sport is powered by a high-feature 3.6L V-6. It is a DOHC engine with variable valve timing that delivers 264 horsepower and 250 lb.-ft. of torque. Equinox's standard Multiflex sliding rear seat can be moved nearly 8 inches fore or aft, as well as reclined. In the aft position, this seat provides generous legroom for three full-size adults and a split seatback with two recline positions. **2009 CHEVROLET HHR**

Powerful and efficient Ecotec engines are at the heart of the HHR. They provide good performance, value and convenience. Variable valve timing added to the base 2.2L Ecotec engine for '09 enables more efficient performance, along with an increase in horsepower from 149 to 155. This enhances the HHR's fuel economy, giving it a driving range of approximately 500 miles. Also new for '09, the HHR's 2.2L and 2.4L Ecotec engines are FlexFuel capable. The HHR brings a turbocharged dose of thrills that is unmatched in the segment. For '09, the GM Performance Division has combined the SS's DNA with the unique HHR Panel to create a limited-edition HHR Panel SS. The HHR SS is a high-performance vehicle like no other. Features such as "no-lift shift" and other driver-selectable performance modes help it achieve 0-60 mph performance in 6.3 seconds. A new SS Performance Package debuts in '09 and includes Brembo four-piston front brake calipers and a limited-slip differential. In addition to the new HHR Panel SS model, variable valve timing for the 2.2L engine and E85 FlexFuel capability for the 2.2L and 2.4L engines, new technology and safety features highlight the cross-lineup changes for 2009, as well as the inclusion of some previously optional equipment as standard. **2009 CHEVROLET IMPALA**

For 2009, Impala's value story is bolstered by new standard safety features, including thorax side-impact airbags and safety belt pretensioners for the front-seat lap belts. Anti-lock brakes and traction control are now standard. Available is new Bluetooth phone connectivity through the OnStar system. The standard 3.5L V-6 is EPA-rated at 29 mpg on the highway, giving it fuel economy that matches or beats many smaller cars. Both the 3.5L and 3.9L engines are available with E85 FlexFuel capability. The Impala SS is an efficient performer, too, with a 5.3L V-8 and Active Fuel Management. It is rated at 303 horsepower. Active Fuel Management can improve fuel economy by up to 12 percent in certain driving conditions. Changes to the 2009 Impala lineup are evolutionary and reflect streamlined packaging of popular features. They include: New-design 18-inch flangeless, polished aluminum wheel for the Impala SS; Four-wheel disc brakes with ABS and traction control are now standard on all models; Common rear spoiler design for all models (SS-style); Revised rocker molding design; Dual-zone manual climate control standard; Revised cupholder design; Illuminated vanity mirrors for driver/front passenger now standard.
